



COUNSELOR EDUCATION DOCTORAL ADVANCED PRACTICUM

2026 Academic Year. We are offering doctoral advanced practicum positions for the Summer 2025 semester. The primary goal of this advanced practicum is to prepare doctoral level counselors to provide generalist counseling services to a college student population. As such, Counselor Education practicum students will participate in a variety of counseling and training activities. The practicum requires a one semester commitment of 20 hours/week to the Counseling and Wellness Center.
